San Diego Streamers October Rally on the Beach

The October San Onofre Rally is fully booked. Here are some reminders:

1. All non-military folks will be required to sign a liability waiver form. Vince will be sending this out soon. Instead of mailing it back to him, just bring it with you when you come on base. We will collect them when you arrive at your site.
2. The sites we have on the beach were designed for motorhomes to pull in straight ahead facing the beach; therefore, the hook ups are on the opposite side when you back-in. You might not need an extension cord for 30 amps but it might be handy to have one on hand just in case.
3. These campsites offer water and electric. There are no sewer hook-ups but one central dump station at the campground.

Directions:

From I-5 North or Southbound take exit 71 (Basilone Rd). Go East to the Gate. At the gate the Marine Sentry will want to see your drivers license and insurance for your vehicle. The Sentry will have a list of participants with their tow vehicle and camper license plate number with your name.

Stay east bound on Basilone Rd until you come to Beach Club Road (traffic light). Turn right and stay on Beach Club Rd until you arrive at the beach.

For parking purposes, please turn left at the Stop sign which directs you up the hill to the club. This is prior to the Life Guard Tower. Follow the road all the way around the back to the beach.

Stop at site 72, first one on the left coming down the hill to receive your site number. There will be parking assistance as some of the sites are fairly tight width wise.

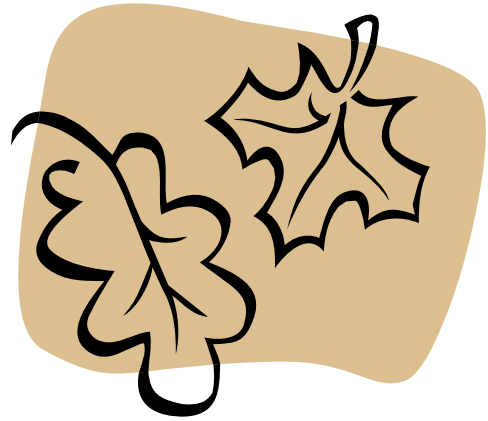
